December's Birthstone & Flowers

The December birthstone is the **turquoise**; the flower are the **narcissus** and the **holly**.

Turquoise is found most often in very dry areas where volcanic activity has occurred. Unlike many other gems, turquo opaque rather than translucent. Its blue-green color can vary from sky blue or greenish blue to pale green or greenish Bluer stones are considered more valuable and contain more copper.

The holly symbolizes your wish for domestic happiness. Although some animals and birds enjoy holly berries, they are semitoxic to humans.

The narcissus conveys that you want your beloved to stay just the way they are. While there are many types of narcissus, the paperwhite is the winter-growing variety and the birth flower for December.

The club will no longer mail out hard copies of the newsletter to members. Those who have provided the club with an email address will continue to receive notifications via email when the newsletter is published for viewing online.



Monthly Meeting Map


