Old Business:

The Nominating Committee is gathering names to be voted on in the October election for President, Second Vice President and Secretary. Contact Patti Felts if you would like to volunteer.

New Business:

The below has been requested to be a change to our club's constitution. Two items were brought up in connection with this subject.

- 1. The entire membership should read the changes before they vote.
- 2. Some of these changes might be better placed under officers' duties instead of a change to the club's constitution.

THE ADDITIONS ARE:

ARTICLE VII Duties of Officers

Section 1. The President will:

- Send the list of officers for the coming year to SCFMS on the designated form from SCFMS within 30 days after the election in November
- Attend the annual SCFMS meeting as a member of the board of directors or send an alternative delegate. The club shall
 provide funds for the president or delegate's travel funds and funds used for attending federation events at the meeting.

Section 5. The Treasurer will:

- File Form 990 for nonprofit organizations with the IRS by the 15th of May each year. (Form 990-N, e-Postcard, can be filed by smaller nonprofits with gross receipts of less than \$50,000).
- Send member dues and insurance fees to SCFMS executive secretary by September each year, no later than September 30th. The number of Club members is based upon the current year. The club is charged per person for insurance based on the current number of members.

The areas capitalized will need to be edited to fit our club.

October's Birthstone & Flowers

The October birthstone is the **topaz**; the flower is the **chrysanthemum**.



Topaz

Topaz is the mineral fluoro-hydroxy silicate and is the hardest of all known silicate minerals. Topaz itself is colorless but impurities within can turn it into almost any color. Yellow or amber is most often associated with topaz. Interestingly, even though blue topaz is rare to find naturally (most for sale have been treated to get the color) it is Imperial topaz (reddish orange with pink undertones) that is the most valuable.

The lone flower for the month of November is the chrysanthemum. It is a perennial and comes in a variety of colors. After they finish blooming in autumn, they can be mulched with straw to protect them from inclement weather.

The club will no longer mail out hard copies of the newsletter to members. Those who have provided the club with an address will continue to receive notifications via email when the newsletter is published for viewing online.




