# February Birthstone & Flowers

The February birthstone is the amethyst; the flowers are the violet and the primrose.

The February birthstone, the amethyst, is said to strengthen relationships and give its wearer courage. Amethysts are a type of quartz often found in geodes amidst cooled lava. Their purple coloring runs the gamut from reddish purple to a bluish lilac. The finest quality is a strongly saturated reddish purple to dark purple as long as the stone does not become too dark to see its brightness.

The February birth month flowers are the violet and the primrose.

Violets signify watchfulness, loyalty, and faithfulness.

The other February birth flower is the primrose, which lets someone know you can't live without them.

They are short wave, mid wave and long wave. Some localities famous for fluorescent minerals are Franklin NJ, Sweden, Greenland, Russia, Arizona, and Terlingua Texas. Lee showed a slide presentation of examples of minerals under UV light. Then after the slide presentation Lee demonstrated how the lights illuminated actual rocks that he brought. Following the presentation, he invited members to bring up any rocks they brought to see if they were fluorescent.
